Program Description and Highlights:

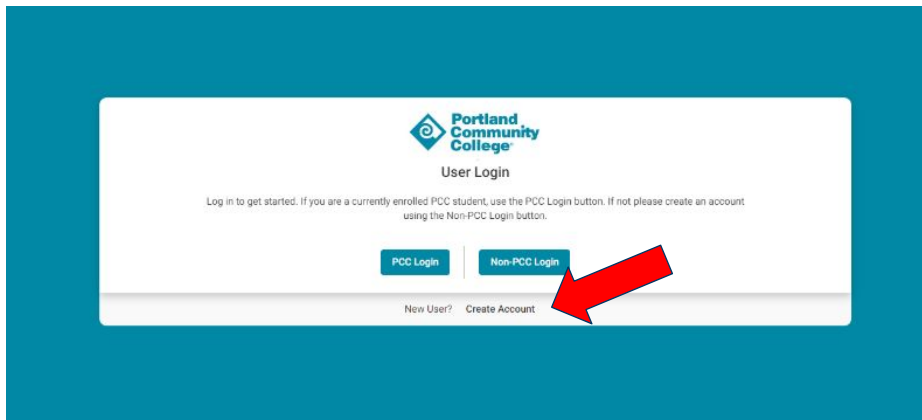
This program examines the socio-economic, behavioral, biological, environmental, and other factors that impact human health and contribute to health disparities. It investigates basic processes, concepts, approaches, and interventions that identify and address the major health-related needs and concerns of populations. It provides an overview and history of the health system and the role of local, state, federal, and global public health entities in health promotion and disease prevention.

The professional field of community and public health uses a holistic model of health with seven different dimensions: physical, emotional, social, environmental, and spiritual. The portion of this program in Croatia will focus on activities



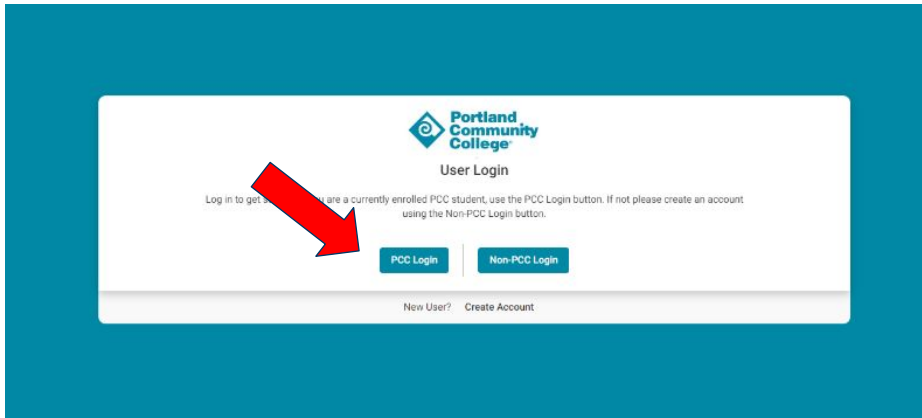

Logging In or Creating an Account





If you are currently enrolled in classes at PCC, use the PCC Login button.

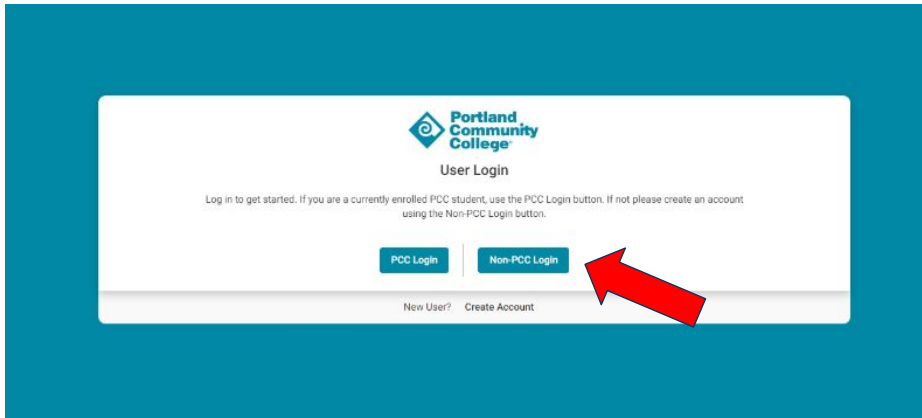

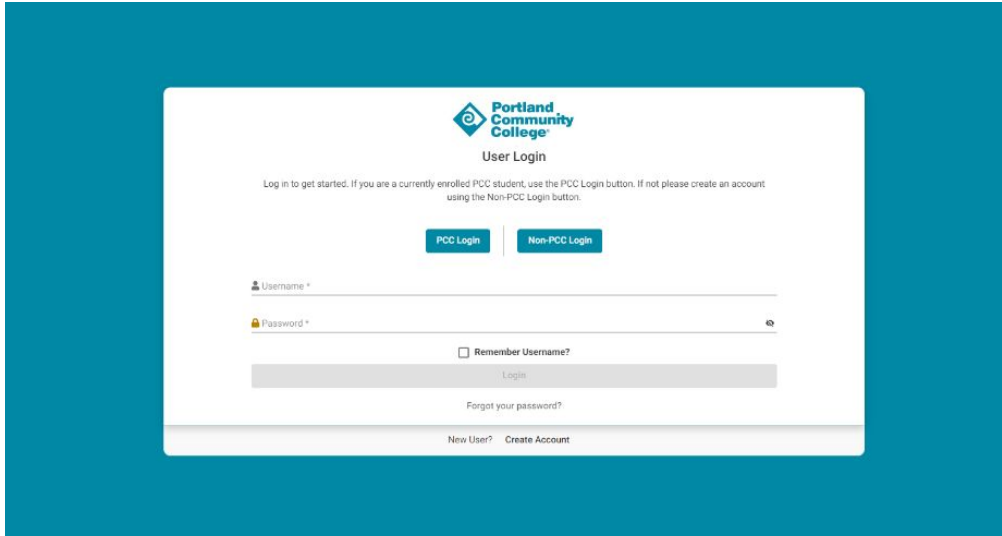
The PCC Login option will direct you to the MyPCC login page where you can use your PCC username and password to access the Education Abroad Portal.

Not currently enrolled?

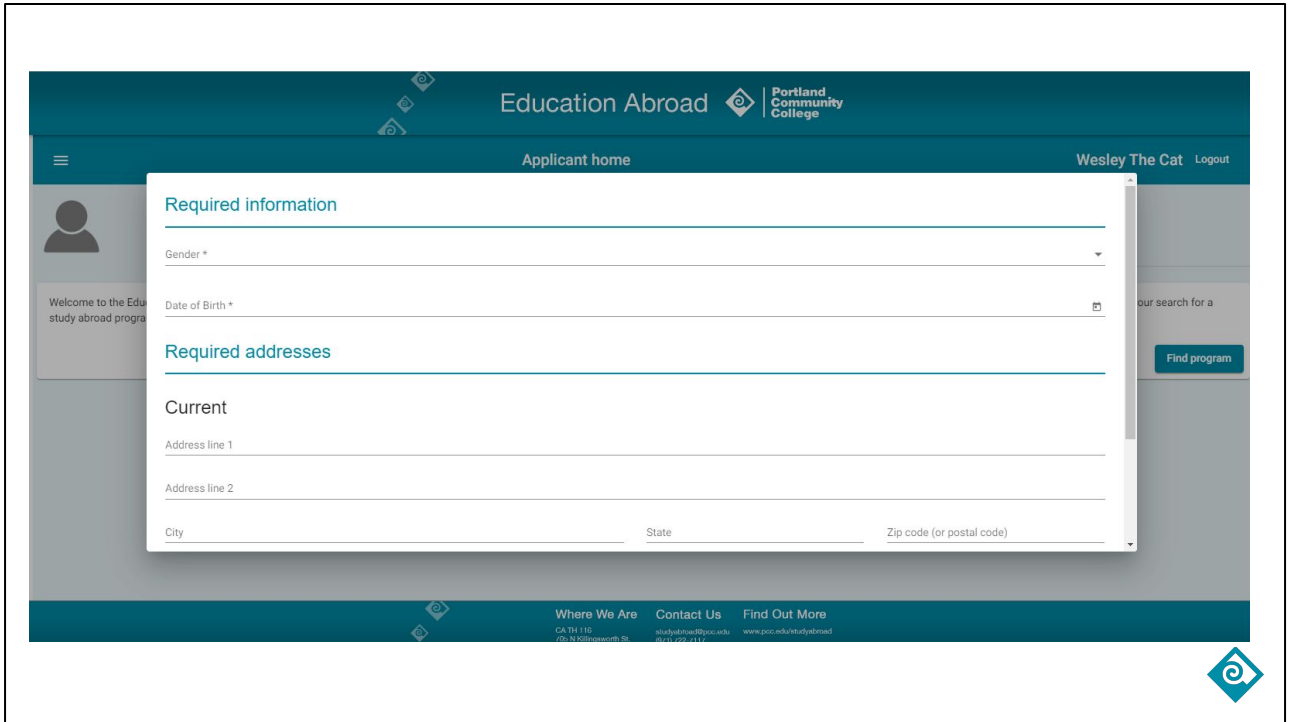

For the sake of the study abroad application you are considered a “new user” (even if you have previously taken classes at PCC). Click on the Create Account link at the bottom of the page to set up your account.

Not currently enrolled?




You will be prompted to type in your login credentials on this page. Remember to type the same username and password that you used to set up your account. This is how you will log in each time you access your application. If you can't recall your password, you can reset it by clicking the "Forgot your password" link below the "login" button.

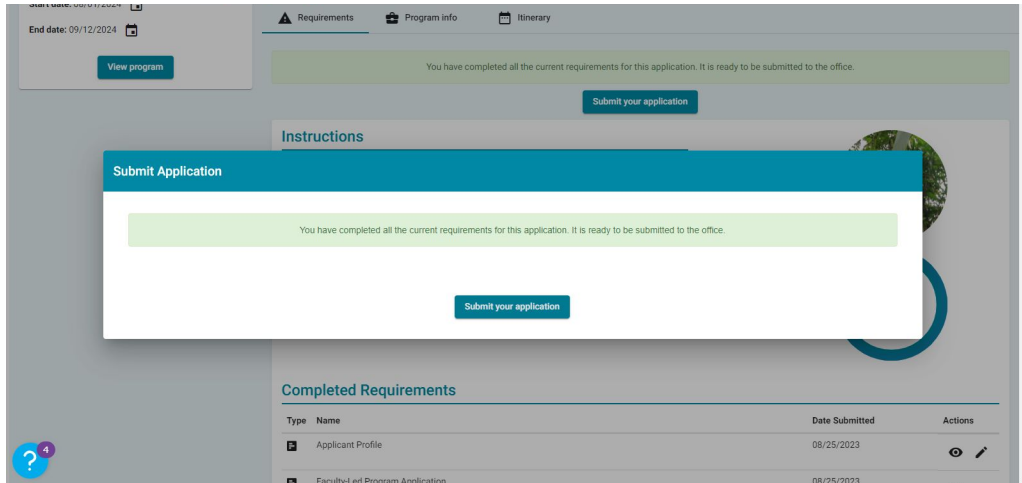

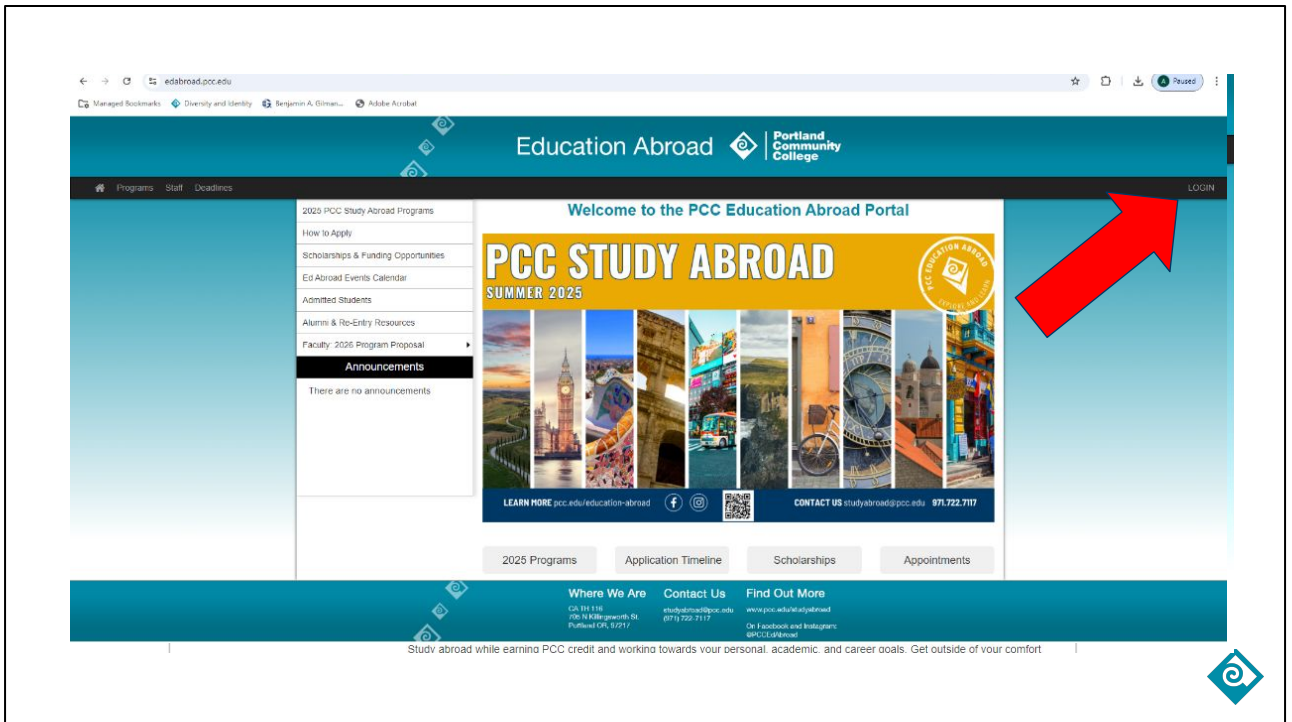

Submit your Application



When you have completed all the requirements, you will be prompted with a “Submit Your Application” box. Click the button to finalize and submit your application. Remember, there is no fee to apply for a PCC study abroad program. Education Abroad Advisors will review your application and communicate via email with your next steps and additional documentation for the next phase of your process.

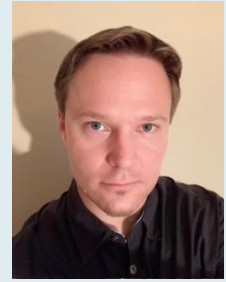
