# PCC Education Abroad: Course Registration & Payment Process

## Course Registration

- Closed CRN
- Instructors will email closed CRNS to their cohorts





Registering for a PCC study abroad course is similar to registering for a regular PCC course with one exception: the CRN (course reference number).


The PCC study abroad course use a closed CRN which allows only the people in your program cohort to register for this class. It's not listed in the course catalog because it's not open to the public. Your closed CRN will come from your instructor via email.

Let's talk about when and where to register for your course...

### When to Register


- PCC Summer Registration
  Takes place in late May
- Check PCC email for priority Registration group and date




Many are well versed, but if you are new to PCC, Summer Registration begins in May. For the exact date and time you can register, click the "When to Register" link on the PCC website



When you are ready to register for your course, navigate to your MyPCC dashboard, then click on the My Courses tab, then select Register for Classes.


Additional instructions will be sent via email with your closed CRN for the course.



If you have issues when you register, navigate back to the Home tab and check the "Term-to-Term" checklist section.

If you see any red flags in the middle grey box, that may indicate an issue to be resolved (ie Holds, academic standing, or placement tests).

Call or email the office to discuss with us directly so we can troubleshoot together.



After you register for the class, your payment (tuition + program fees) will be posted to student account.

- Remember the \$500 deposit that you submitted to hold your spot on the program? This amount will <u>not be reflected</u> in this total.
- It's ok, it's just a systems issue at PCC. We have records that validate your deposit, so do not worry!

To view your Bill, navigate to the MyPCC homepage, click the "Paying for College" tab, then click the "View my bill in PCC-Pay" link.

This page should look familiar, since it is where you submitted your deposit.


From here, you can submit your summer term payment and view your statement for a breakdown of the costs.

The Account Summary includes two columns: "Charges" and "Credits".

- Note that your total study abroad fee appears under Charges with the tuition. Remember that this is the total program fee as shared on the program page website
- Notice that the Credit column on the right is empty. Your \$500 deposit will appear here <u>only after July 1</u>. Before July 1 you will not see your deposit. Do not worry - we have a record that you have paid the deposit!



This process is clunky! It is a PCC systems issue, so we have to work within the system as best we can. Our goal is to provide you with information so that you can be prepared.

# Payment Process

PCC Tuition + Remaining Program Fee

#### **Student Account:**

- The total amount (PCC tuition + program fees) will be posted
- \$500 deposit not included in this total

#### 3 Payment Options:


- Pay over the phone (actual amount owed, with \$500 calculated)
- Pay in person at Student Accounts on any campus (actual amount owed)
- Pay Online via PCC-Pay in MyPCC (refund \$500 in summer term)

Payment Due Date = Same as PCC Summer Due Date



When it comes time to pay, you have 3 payment options:

- Pay via phone or in person to pay total of what you owe which is minus \$500 you already paid (tell the person you have already deposited \$500 for your study abroad program)
- If you pay via PCC-Pay online, you will see the whole amount on your bill and will pay that whole amount. You are not able to adjust the amount to pay. You will receive a refund of \$500 to your account during the summer term. This is like a true deposit!



Please plan to pay your bill by the deadline or you will be dropped from the course. This is called "Dropped for Non-Payment".

If you receive a Scholarship or plan to use Financial Aid, make sure to chat with us or the appropriate office so you do not get dropped for non-payment.

Keep in mind that your academic standing is now tied to Financial Aid. This means you need to maintain your GPA above a 2.0, be successful completing 66.67% of your attempted credit requirements, and keep your maximum credit limit in mind to maintain your Financial Aid Student Academic Progress. If you see a flag in this area, it might indicate a Financial Aid issue in future terms.
