- In development

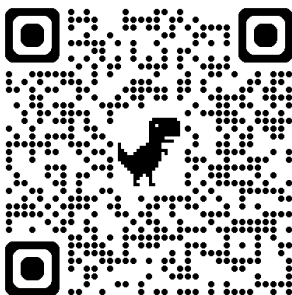
