SKILLS SECTION

Think about what you are learning in school, from life, work, and service work. Lived Experience or Academic Competency it does not matter – list them. What counseling techniques are you trained in using? What is

your understanding of SUD and/or your philosophy? Other skills may come from your self-care routine, recovery work or hobbies. Example: Weight lifting, rock climbing, yoga, running. This might also go in your profile section or a cover letter

EXPERIENCE (current and previous paid or unpaid)

This section can be broken into relevant and not. Within each type start with the most recent and then work back in time. Where have you worked? It may be useful no matter how long ago or how impermanent. If you don't have any - no biggie – your focus will be on skills and academics whatever will show you in your best light. If you have volunteered or service work move to that section. Start with your most recent experience and then work backward in time.

If your work experience is less than what you like or you can't see relevant skills—you can do a Past Work Summary Job Title, Company, City, State, Mo/Year one after the other and no other details. Then your resume focus is on the skills section
